#### What is Youth Tour?

This delegate will travel with approximately 90 students from across Missouri for a week of sightseeing, learning and fun June 10-16, 2016.

any current high school junior attending a school or being home schooled in one of the five counties served by AHEC—Atchison, Holt and Nodaway in Missouri; or Fremont and Page in Iowa. The parent or legal guardian must be a member of the Cooperative.

#### **Essay Requirements:**

Each contestant is required to write and submit a typed, double-spaced essay of at least 500, but no more than 750, words in length. The topic of your essay will be "A Day Without Electricity". Discuss what a day would be like for you without electricity.
